#### Subspecialty Examination in Strabismus & Paediatric Ophthalmology

The European Board of Ophthalmology (EBO), in collaboration with the European Strabismological Association (ESA) and the European Paediatric Ophthalmological Society (EPOS), is pleased to announce that the EBO Strabismus and Paediatric Ophthalmology Subspecialty Exam 2026 is now open for applications.

The exam is held the day before the EPOS annual conference in **Bucharest, Romania**. Candidates will have reduced admission fee for the **EPOS congress**

#### Purpose of the Exam

The examination is designed to provide formal recognition of advanced clinical expertise in both Strabismus and Paediatric Ophthalmology, harmonising specialist standards across Europe and supporting professional development in these subspecialty fields.

Successful candidates will be awarded the Fellow of the EBO Subspecialty Strabismus and Paediatric Ophthalmology Diploma (FEBOS-SP), a prestigious certification acknowledging high-level competence in this subspecialty.

#### Who Should Apply

This exam is intended for ophthalmologists who:

- Have trained in a UEMS member or associate country.
- Hold a basic EBO diploma (or equivalent qualification).\*
- Have successfully finished at least 12 months of full-time fellowship training in Strabismus and Paediatric Ophthalmology to ICO standards (or equivalent).
- Can demonstrate sufficient surgical experience in strabismus and paediatric ophthalmology cases.
